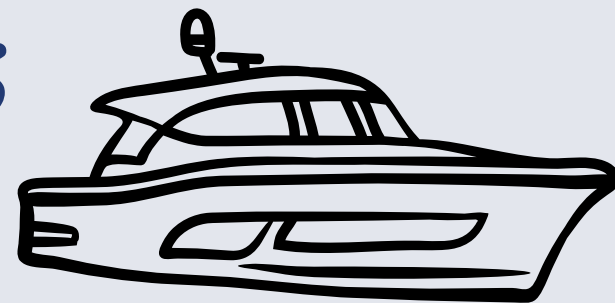
Medical Experts: Medical professionals can explain the extent of injuries, the necessary treatments, and the long-term impact on the victim's health and quality of life.

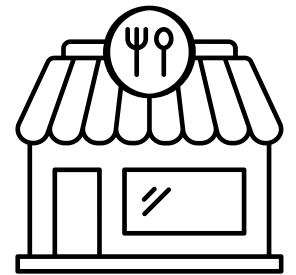
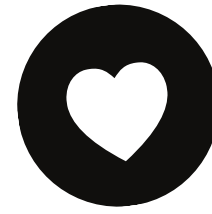
Boating Safety Tips

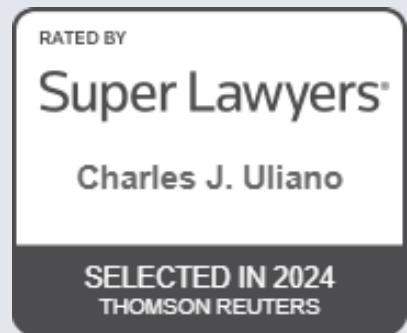
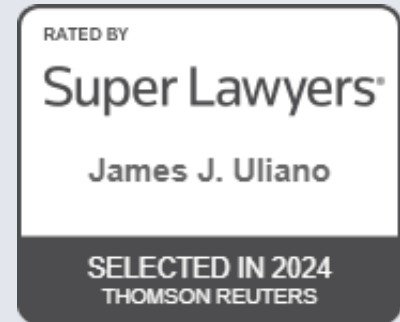
